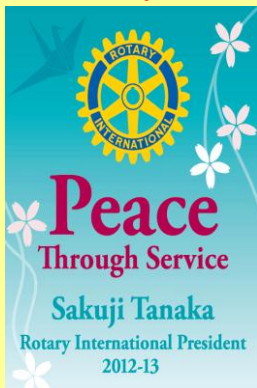

Retired Episcopal Bishop, Rev. Dan Edward

Bishop Dan grew up in rural East Texas and attended the University of Texas for undergraduate and law schools before heading to Colorado for a legal aid job representing migrant farmworkers. After three years driving the beet fields, he moved to Idaho where he practiced law for the next decade and became an Episcopalian along the way. He then attended General Theological Seminary where he received his M. Div. (cum laude) and an S. T. M. in spiritual direction. He later studied at Harvard Divinity School on a Merrill Fellowship and at Columbia Theological Seminary on a Guthrie Scholarship. His first two priestly calls were both in Macon, Georgia where he served over 17 years. He was active there in training spiritual directors and in racial reconciliation work. He was elected the 10th Bishop of Nevada and was consecrated in January, 2008. *God Of Our Silent Tears*, his book on how God responds to suffering, will be released later this year. He has served as a Commissioner for Nevada Volunteers and is active with Nevadans For the Common Good, which is currently engaged in combating Human Trafficking in Nevada.
