ANNOUNCEMENTS

Tom Martin announced the upcoming "Feed the Homeless" on Wednesday, January 31, 2018, at Christ Church Episcopal on Maryland Parkway. Be there at 5:00 p.m. We will also be distributing clothes and hygiene supplies.

Adrienne Cox announced details of the upcoming GSE cultural exchange team from India. Let Adrienne know ASAP if you know a young, non-Rotarian professional who would like to experience a Rotary International Group Cultural Exchange (GCE). A three week immersive trip to India is scheduled for April 1-21, 2018. Participants will be home hosted by primarily Rotary families in District 3261. The Rotary Clubs of that district will prepare experiences that highlight their region's ethnicities, food, language, history, places of interest, economy and more. In addition and as part of the GCE, District 5300 will host a 5-member team from India during the same time. This will also require the robust participation of Rotary Clubs throughout the District. We will need to arrange an itinerary and activities in all 5 areas of D 5300. Included in hosting these five team members, is providing lodging with families, transportation within the District, daily events, food, entrance costs for any fee-based activities etc. .

President Ron reminded the club members that we have been asked by Rotary International President Ian Riseley to plant a tree for every Rotarian around the globe. Following a brief discussion of how to accomplish the goal, it was apparently "punted" to the next board meeting on 2/5.

General Announcement – District Governor Khoury - January is Vocational Month! Vocational Service is one of Rotary's Avenues of Service. Vocational Service calls every Rotarian to:
