**TODAY’S PROGRAM** – Our speaker today Marvin Menzies, head men’s basketball coach for the University of Nevada, Las Vegas Runnin’ Rebels and 2015 WAC Coach of the Year.

He officially took over the reins of the program in April 2016 and is entering his third season with the Running Rebels.

He came to UNLV from New Mexico State University where he was 2015 WAC Coach of the Year and led the aggies to four regular season WAC championships, four WAC Tournament championships, Four NCAA Tournament births, five straight 20-win seasons, 7 in 8 years, as well as owned a 35 straight home conference game win streak, second-longest in the nation. He possesses a 198-111 record over nine seasons as a Division I head coach and has won nearly 75 percent of in-conference games.

Coach Menzies has a reputation as one of the nation's best recruiters. He was hired to lead the program in Las Cruces in 2007 after spending two seasons as an assistant coach under Rick Pitino at Louisville. Prior to joining the Cardinals' staff, Coach Menzies spent one year at UNLV under Lon Kruger.

Before his time at UNLV, Coach Menzies was at USC for a season under Henry Bibby, and he spent four years at San Diego State under Steve Fisher. During his early career he had coaching positions at Santa Monica College, Cal State Sacramento and began his coaching career at his prep alma mater, Hamilton High School in Los Angeles, California.

Notes from the presentation:

1. Prior to his arriving, the team had never had a collective GPA 3.0 or higher. Since taking over, they have consistently been over 3.0 and one of the players even had a perfect 4.0.
2. He preaches “character” and “culture”.
3. UNLV game attendance ranks 32<sup>nd</sup> out of the 351 Division 1 teams.
4. The CEO of Allegiant Air has provided a charter jet for team trips.
5. He would love to see more season ticket holders.
6. He says that his hottest prospect right now is a young man (who shall remain nameless) out of Bonanza High School right here in Las Vegas who spent most of his time wrestling but who can hit “three’s” from anywhere on the court even though he has been gone from BHS for some time. Unfortunately the young man is under contract to Meadows Bank.

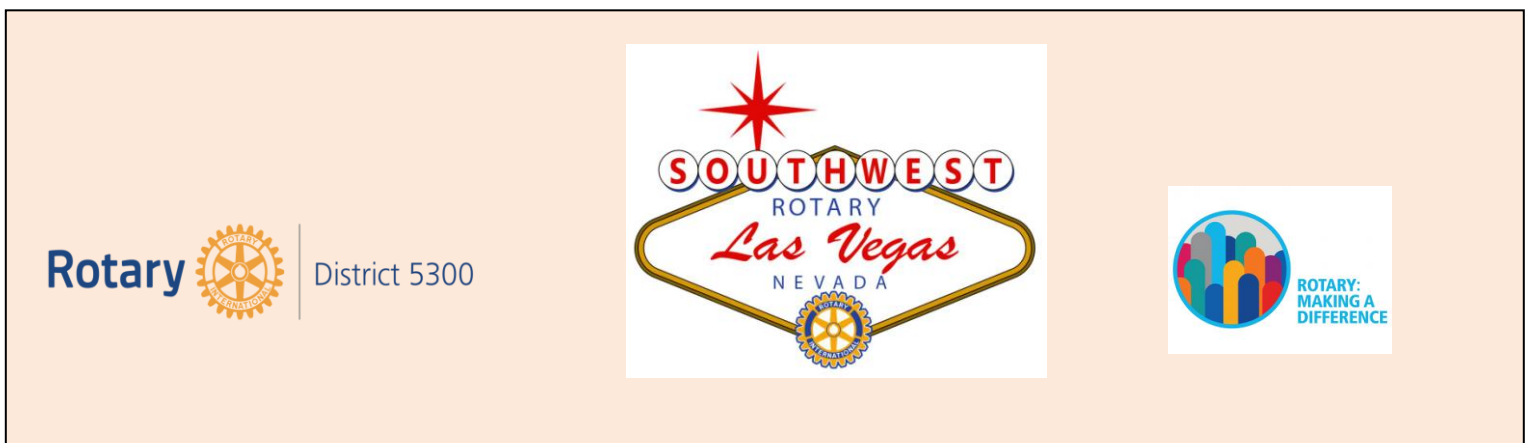
