The Object of Rotary

THE OBJECT of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

FIRST The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;

SECOND High ethical standards in business and professions, the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

THIRD The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;

FOURTH The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service

The Four-Way Test

OF THE THINGS we think, say, or do:

- 1) Is it the **TRUTH**?
- 2) Is it **FAIR** to all concerned?
- 3) Will it build **GOODWILL** and **BETTER FRIENDSHIPS**?
- 4) Will it be **BENEFICIAL** to all concerned?

Rotarian Code of Conduct

The following code of conduct has been adopted for the use of Rotarians:

AS A ROTARIAN, I will

- 1) Act with integrity and high ethical standards in my personal and professional life
- 2) Deal fairly with others and treat them and their occupations with respect
- 3) Use my professional skills through Rotary to: mentor young people, help those with special needs, and improve people's quality of life in my community and in the world
- 4) Avoid behavior that reflects adversely on Rotary or other Rotarians

ROTARY MOMENT

Ted Henderson – shared an emotional experience when one of his Rotary International Exchange called him on Christmas from a phone booth sharing that she had never been away from home at Christmas.

Rebecca Collett – shared a recent moment after the Debunking, late at night at the Mob Museum Speakeasy located in the basement. A security guard approached me and asked if I was Rebecca. I said yes and he told me that he was told I was the person to see. It was very loud and he needed to get closer to be heard. He crouched down next to my chair and then I got nervous.

I wondered what I may have done or maybe a Rotarian had done and if we were possibly in trouble.

He told me that when he heard that Rotary was in the building he had to talk to someone. He proceeded to tell me that when he was deployed in Afghanistan he and his fellow servicemen received regular shipments from Rotary, and he knew it was not our Club but he had to find us to thank us.

He was so very sincere and so very sweet and explained that those shipments kept them all going. They were reminders of home and they made such a huge and lasting impact on everyone.

He thanked me over and over and I was insisting that the thanks are from us to them for their selfless service and it is for all of us to be eternally grateful not him.

He so humbly insisted that we were the ones to thank and that Rotary will always be remembered by everyone he was deployed with.

I thanked him to making the effort to find us and let him know what it meant to us to know how Rotary impacts lives all over the world and moments like that were why we do what we do.

It was such a great moment and I did not want it to end - but he had to leave.

So I was so grateful and so proud of Rotary and thought it was the perfect end to a perfect evening.

RECOGNITIONS

Karl announced that this would be his first time giving out fines – so we all cringed and held our collective breath.

\$50 Ted Henderson – recognized for his birthday last month. Karl started at 80 which was 8 days of Ted's travels at \$10 a day and then Ted argued that he had shared such an emotional Rotary Moment so Karl indicated that he would take that into consideration and lowered the fine to \$50.

\$50 Tom Martin – was recognized for a photo of his Grandson John (yes, the awesome one) that showed his immediate family pictured with the entire Vegas Golden Knights Team and Karl asked Tom to explain the photo. Photo was sent to Karl by “a little bird”, he says. Tom shared that he could not since it took place when he was not in town and only heard a little about it but was only now seeing the photo for the first time. He pled total ignorance, his own words, and said he would have to find out more. Karl let him off with a \$50 fine.

SPEAKER

Our Speaker was **Kevin Janison**, yes, tv weather guy and also a children's book author.

He told us about the Speaking Presentations that he does for students which includes the process of writing a book, getting it illustrated and published. This is a literacy and career encouraging venture for kids.

Seems the illustrator was chosen based on his art and when Kevin was turned down twice by the illustrator (via the publisher), he decided to try one more time on his own and found the Illustrator live right here in Sun City Anthem. He convinced the illustrator and the results are these 4 books. Recently the Illustrator announced that he was officially retired and now Kevin will be creating a new

character and move to a new illustrator.
